**Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria Contributes
\$5,000.00 towards Repair and Re-Painting of Veterans
Memorial Building in Fortuna, CA**

The Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2207 in Fortuna, CA is pleased to announce and acknowledge the generous contribution of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) from the Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria towards the repair and refurbishment of the Veterans Memorial Building in Fortuna, CA.

The re-painting of the Veterans Memorial Building is complete and a dedication of a commemorative plaque acknowledging the contribution from the Tribe and photo of members of the Tribal Council along with members of VFW Post 2207 will be held on Friday morning, January 30, 2015 at 10:30am at the Veterans Memorial Building in Fortuna, CA.
