TO ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS: The Regular Tribal Election will be held on March 26, 2016. A packet including a Second Notice of the Election and a copy of qualifications submitted by those candidates who chose to do so by the February 26, 2016 deadline, will be mailed to all eligible voters not later than March 12, 2016. Eligible voters who requested an Absentee Ballot or are Permanent Absentee Voters will also receive an Absentee Ballot, Instructions for submitting an Absentee Ballot, a Ballot Envelope and a stamped envelope addressed to the League of Women Voters of Humboldt County Elections Service Post Office Box 3806. If you did not request an Absentee Ballot, or if your request reached us after the filing deadline, you may vote in person on March 26, 2016 from 8 AM to 4 PM.

If you intended to run for office but your Intent was received after the February 26, 2016 deadline, you may still register as an official Write-in Candidate by submitting the pink Intent to be a Write-In Candidate form, also included in the mailing with a return envelope, to the League Post Office Box 3806 before March 21, 2016.

The Tribal Council has defined two proposed Constitutional Amendments for the March 2016 election. They are:

- 1. Shall the Constitution be amended to allow currently enrolled adopted members the right to vote and hold office? YES or NO**
- 2. Shall the Constitution be amended to place a permanent enrollment moratorium, only to individuals that are 18 and older that apply for membership? Minors that are 17 years of age and younger and newborns will still be able to enroll in Bear River should enrollment criteria be met. YES or NO**

A complete explanation of these proposed Constitutional Amendments, showing the exact changes to the Constitution, will be included in your mailed Second Notice of Election packet.

Constitutional Amendments require that at least 45% of the eligible voters take part in the election, with a majority of those voting in favor of the amendment for it to pass.
