Re: Tish Non Homeownership Housing Application

The Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria is applying for FY2019 & FY2020 Indian Community Development Block Grant funding. We also have sixteen (16) multifamily rental units to be awarded this year funded by Indian Housing Block Grant FY2019 and Tribal Funds. If you are 18 years old or older, don't own your home, haven't been previously assisted with down payment assistance or previously been given a HUD home, please submit a current Homeownership Housing Application if you would like to be considered for one of these opportunities. These HUD homes do have income eligibility limitations but, if you submit the application, I'll provide a letter if you appear over income based on the estimated income you provide.

We require current applications from all Tribal families that would like to be considered in the rating/ranking described in our Housing Policy. Complete the enclosed application and return to my attention at your earliest convenience if you want to be considered for the homes under rehab this year. You must have a current application (after December 31, 2020) to be considered. I have many names that have submitted applications in past years. You must provide an updated application to be considered for one of these opportunities.

Be sure to include all forms of income shown on the list including all public assistance and Tribal per capita. You don't need to send income verification copies at this time – these will be requested from the highest preliminarily rated/ranked applicants when needed.

Be aware that all applicants are also subject to the screening criteria in the Tish Non Village Housing Policy.

This is a tremendous opportunity – Please submit an application and encourage other Tribal members to submit applications as well.
