Emergency Rental Assistance Housing/ Utilities ASSISTANCE

The Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria is the recipient the Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) Program. These program provides financial assistance to help tribal member individuals and families during this Pandemic. Requirements are as follows:

- Bear River Tribal Member Household or be a Bear River Tenant
- Household must be financially impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic ·
 - Qualifies for unemployment or has experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19
 - Demonstrates a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability
Household Income Qualifications: Must be at or below 80% of Humboldt County LMI (low to moderate income)
 - Priority will be given to those with income at or below 50% LMI · and to households with one or more members that have been unemployed for at least 90 days prior to the household's application for assistance.

CHECKLIST:

- Signed Application
- Income/Financial impact Verification: current check stub and/or previous check stub (3 months) affidavit or, IRS 1040 for 2020
- Other documentation proof needed by the Housing Department.
