**CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NOTICE**

The Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria is eligible for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development: Office of Public and Indian Housing's Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) Imminent Threat funding provided under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ICDBG-ARP). Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria is eligible for up to \$1,035,000 under this funding opportunity and falls in tier two of the second priority ranking for funding. In accordance with the streamlined ICDBG program requirements due to the COVID-19 emergency, Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria will accept and consider comments on the following proposed project.

The purpose of proposed project is to reduce COVID-19 risks by reducing overcrowded households. Program staff have determined that the most efficient method to accomplishing this is to use these funds to finish the 2019/2020 ICDBG funded townhome project, as currently estimated costs are in excess of the projected amounts funded by the 2019/2020 ICDBG due to various factors. ICDBG-ARP funds will be requested to bridge the difference in 2019/2020 ICDBG total project cost compared to the current estimates we have for total project cost.

The 2019/2020 ICDBG project is a new construction project of six townhome units—each unit consisting of three (3)-bedrooms 1.5 bathrooms—to be constructed at Tish Non Village on the Rancheria on Bowie Road.
